On behalf of our respective organizations, we write in support of S. 714, your bill to reauthorize the Federal Land Transaction Facilitation Act (FLTFA).

FLTFA is a fiscally responsible and important land conservation tool for the West. Through FLTFA's "land for land" concept, BLM sells land identified for disposal and generates funding for BLM, USFS, NPS and USFWS to acquire critical inholdings and edgeholdings from willing sellers. Through this balanced approach, the BLM sold land to private land owners, counties, companies and others for ranching, community development and various projects. The sales revenue provided funding for BLM realty staff and administration of the program and allowed agencies to acquire high-priority lands with recreational access, historic significance and ecological importance.
