

- Sent to Unit Presidents and Secretary or Secretary/Treasurers
- Based on those that join unit through AFS, does not include any unit members that join directly through the chapter
- Divisions are automatically assigned
- You can only join AFS Sections through AFS
- You can ask AFS for a list of any non-renewed members
- Once a member has paid their dues, they cannot add/edit their membership online; however, the membership staff can add a unit on the backend


